PROPOSED ANNEXATION

The Tres Pinos Water District is struggling to provide safe and reliable drinking water to their residents. This small water system has limited means for operations and maintenance, the productivity of the well is declining, and the infrastructure is aging and inadequate to meet health and safety standards.

Through annexation into Sunnyslope County Water District (SSCWD), Tres Pinos residents will receive water that meets health and safety standards. In addition, water storage deficiencies will be remedied as well as improvements to aging infrastructure. Additionally, Annexation will meet the conditions of the State Mandated Moratorium

PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENTS

The District's Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on April 21, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. at the Tres Pinos School located at 5635 Airline Hwy, Tres Pinos CA 95075.

At this hearing, members of the public will have the opportunity to provide comments regarding the proposed change in water services. Representatives from **LAFCO** will also be present to answer questions about the annexation process.

Written comments may be submitted during the Public Hearing (date and time noted above), provided they are received prior to the conclusion of the public comment portion of the Public Hearing.

Comments must: (1) specifically identify what is being objected/supported; (2) provide the location of the identified parcel (by assessor's parcel number or street address); and (3) include the printed name and signature of the person who is listed as the property owner.

The Board will hear and consider all written and oral comments to the proposed annexation at the Public Hearing on April 21, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. and consider adoption of a resolution to initiate the annexation process through the San Benito Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO).
